**Assessment**

Units 1 and 4 are assessed through an examination, set and marked by the ASA Awarding Body.

Units 2, 3, 5, and 6 are assessed by a tutor/assessor. Unit 6 must be assessed by the tutor/assessor who assesses Unit 5. Evidence of achievement of some of the elements for units 6 may be provided by a trained Expert Witness in the vocational environment.

All units will be subject to internal verification by the Centre's Internal Verifier.

All programmes will be subject to external verification by the ASA Awarding Body.

**Certificates**

Will be issued to candidates by the Awarding Body upon successful achievement of all 6 units. Please note this can take up to 8 weeks.

**Deadlines**

Please note that you will be given various task deadlines throughout the course, these are non-negotiable.

**Role of ASA Level 2 Teacher**

Achievement of this qualification will enable the candidate to seek employment (paid or voluntary) as an aquatics teacher.

Once qualified the holder of the Level 2 Certificate in Teaching Aquatics will be able to plan, deliver and evaluate teaching sessions.

As Units 1 to 3 are common to all the aquatic disciplines, candidates wishing to progress to a level 2 coaching discipline may do so by undertaking Units 4 to 6 in that discipline, providing they have already achieved Unit 2 of the relevant ASA/UKCC Level 1 qualification or have gained an exemption from the ASA Awarding Body

Places are restricted to 12 and will be allocated strictly in order of receipt of application forms and remittance.
